- I. "By what power or what name did you do this?" [Acts 4:1-12]
  - A. Proclaiming in Jesus the Resurrection of the Dead
  - B. But many who heard the message believed; so the number of men who believed grew to about five thousand.
  - C. It is by the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed.
  - D. Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other Name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved
  - E. Philippians 2:9-11
  
- II. "When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus." [Acts 4:13-22]
  - A. But since they could see the man who had been healed standing there with them, there was nothing they could say.
  - B. But to stop this thing from spreading any further among the people, we must warn them to speak no longer to anyone in this Name
  - C. But Peter and John replied, "Which is right in God's eyes: to listen to you, or to Him? You be the judges! As for us, we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard."
  - D. Philippians 3:10-11
  
- III. "Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness." [Acts 4:23-31]
  - A. On their release, Peter and John went back to their own people and reported all that the chief priests and the elders had said to them.
  - B. "Sovereign Lord," they said, "You made the heavens and the earth and the sea, and everything in them. You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of Your servant, our father David [Psalm 2:1-2]
  - C. Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable Your servants to speak Your word with great boldness. Stretch out Your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the Name of Your Holy Servant Jesus."
  - D. After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
