Intro: A Heart of Devotion [Acts 2:42]

(G4342) proskartereo: to believe in and follow the practices of; consistent; steadfast; continue all the time; persevere; constantly ready to execute

- I. What Communion means to us [1 Corinthians 11:23-26]
 - A. [25] "Do this in remembrance of Me"
 - B. [26] "Proclaim the Lord's death until He comes"
 - 1. God loves you and offers a wonderful plan for your life [John 3:16; 10:10; Jer 29:11]
 - 2. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." [Ro 3:23]
 - 3. "The wages of sin is death" [Ro 6:23]
 - 4. "But while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" [Ro 5:8]
 - 5. "If we confess with our mouth 'Jesus is Lord' and believe in our hearts that He died for our sins, we will be saved" [Ro 10:9-10]
 - 6. "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved" [Ro 10:13]
 - 7. "Nothing can separate you from the love of God" [Romans 8:31-39]
 - 8. We have peace with God [Ro 5:1] and are no longer condemned [Ro 8:1]
 - C. [24-26] "Eat & Drink": a Declaration of Total Dependence [John 6:53-57; 63]
